**Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI) for conducting mid-term evaluation of activities undertaken under CAMPA in the state of Odisha.**

The Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) is a national programme funded by the Ministry of Environment, Forests, and Climate Change, Government of India, being implemented in all the states of the country. Under this activity large scale activities have been taken up to accelerate preservation of natural forests, management of wildlife, infrastructure development in the sector and other allied works. State governments are implementing CAMPA works in their respective states. In Odisha, the **Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA)** was constituted vide Notification No. 13995/F&E dated 14.08.2009 with an objective of Conservation, Protection, Regeneration and Management of existing natural forests, Wildlife and their habitat and raising Site Specific Compensatory Afforestation, and Penal Compensatory Afforestation etc. The state CAMPA has so far formulated six Annual Plans of Operation (APO) and two Additional APO 2011-12 and Additional APO 2013-14 starting with APO 2009-10. Major activities taken up under CAMPA in the state can be broadly classified under following headings:

- Compensatory Afforestation
- Conservation, Regeneration & Management of Natural Forests
- Forest Protection
- Forest Fire Prevention & Control
- Infrastructure development
- Wildlife Management
- Eco-development Programme
- Capacity building
- Research and Development

There is now, felt need to technically evaluate these ongoing efforts and from the learnings plan, the way forward. Also, the state CAMPA guideline stipulate that a

concurrent / mid-term monitoring and evaluation of the works implemented has to be evolved to ensure effective and proper utilization of earmarked funds. These evaluations need to go beyond status assessment and develop deeper to ascertain the effectiveness of inputs as well as cause behind the success or failure to enable better planning and design of the future activities.

In view of the above, Odisha State Forest Department proposes to conduct a mid-term evaluation of various activities undertaken by the Department under CAMPA. Reputed academic institutions with minimum 10 years of experience of research and consultancy in related field are invited to submit their Expression of Interest for conducting the mid-term evaluation. The institution, along with the letter expressing their interest to undertake the activity, would also submit a brief note about the institutions, its accomplishments and experiences in conducting related studies. Institutions having experience in working on forestry related issues and having headquarters in the state of Odisha will be given preference.

Odisha Forest Department, on the basis of the competency of the institution will select and invite one or more institutions for a presentation in front of the concerned officers of the Forest Department (for detail about the details of CAMPA visit website [www.odishaforest.in](http://www.odishaforest.in) ). The presentation will include both technical and financial details of the project. Technical details will basically deals with methodology to be adopted for the study, and financial details will explain the budget required for the purpose. It may be noted that only shortlisted institution/s will be invited for the presentation.
