

FOREST FIRE PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN, 2026 OF MAYURBHANJ DISTRICT

(1) INTRODUCTION:-

Brief outline and background

Forest fire is large, potentially destructive and mostly happen due to human activities. It is one of the most common and recurrent hazards affecting forest ecosystems. It poses a serious threat not only to forest wealth but also to the entire regime of flora and fauna, thereby significantly disturbing biodiversity, ecology, and the environment of a region. In recent years, incidents of forest fire have drawn heightened attention of the Government due to their adverse impact on forest resources, wildlife, and human life.

In order to safeguard forests and minimize loss to forest resources, wildlife, and human life due to forest fires, the Government has decided to adopt a convergence-based approach involving all stakeholders. The overarching goal is to progressively achieve Forest Fire Free Panchayats, leading to Forest Fire Free Divisions and Districts by the year 2026. Accordingly, Government guidelines have been issued for the preparation of District Action Plans on Forest Fire Prevention and Management for the ensuing fire season, 2026.

Analysis of forest fire alerts from previous years reveals that more than 70% of the fire incidents are repetitive in nature, occurring in the same villages or locations as in earlier fire seasons. This clearly indicates the need for strong and focused preventive measures as the cornerstone of the action plan.

To strengthen prevention efforts, services of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs), Vana Suraksha Samitis (VSS), Self Help Group (SHG) members, and youth-based organizations such as NCC, NSS, and NYKS shall be effectively utilized. For mitigation and response measures, support from District Fire Services, District Police, District Disaster Management Units, Kendu Leaf seasonal staff, and Forest Squads shall be mobilized.

Special emphasis shall be placed on preventing repeat forest fire incidents in villages and locations where fires occurred during the year 2025. There shall be zero tolerance towards repeat forest fire incidents, and the frontline staff of the Forest Department shall be held responsible for ensuring strict preventive and responsive measures during the fire season of 2026.

The Forest administration of Mayurbhanj District as per the Departmental Notification No. 25673/F&E, Date 29.11.2018 spread over five Divisions i.e. Similipal South (WL) Division (Headquarter at Baripada), Similipal North (WL) Division (Head quarter at Jashipur), Rairangpur Forest Division (Headquarters at Rairangpur), Karanjia Forest Division (Headquarter at Karanjia) and Baripada Forest Division (Head quarter at Baripada).

Similipal Wildlife Sanctuary has an area of 2306.61Sq. Km. and Similipal Tiger Reserve is spread over 2750 Sq. Km.

-Protected area in Mayurbhanj District: -

- (i) **Similipal Sanctuary:** - 2306.61 Sq. Km area declared vide Notification No.6484/6F(WL)2/200/F&E on the 23rd April 2008.
- (ii) **Similipal Tiger Reserve:** - As per section 38V of the chapter IVB of the Wildlife (protection) Act. 1972 and prior approval of NTCA, Similipal Tiger Reserve is declared vide Notification No.- 8F(T)- 9/2007/20801/F&E on 31.12.2007.

Area: - Core area – 1194.75Sq Km
Buffer area - 1555.25Sq.Km
Total area – 2750.00Sq Km

(iii) **Similipal Notional Park:** - Area 845.70 Sq. Km

Similipal is declared as National Park in April-2025 covering 845.70 Sq. Km and offers greater protection for its unique Melanistic Tigers and rich ecosystem.

(iv) **Similipal Biosphere Reserve:** - Area 5569 Sq. Km.

Government of India declared Similipal Tiger Reserve and surrounding transitional zone as a biosphere reserve in 1994. UNESCO added to World Net work of Biosphere reserve in May- 2009. This was noticed vide Notification No. 8F(T)8/96/11319 date 20.05.1996 of Govt.of Odisha.

Causes of Fire**A. ANTHROPOGENIC CAUSES**

1. **Collection of NTFP particularly Mahua flower during summer:** - Clearance of forest floor by way of uncontrolled and irrational fire by the mohua flower collectors.
2. **Poaching of wild animals:** - Poachers put fire in forests for driving the wildlife to a particular direction to make it succumb to the attack.
3. **Encroachment-** Clearance of forest growth through burning for facilitating the agriculture, housing and other purposes with less effort.
4. **Ill intension-** Throwing inflammable materials like lighted bidis and cigarettes carelessly while passing through forest and sometimes ill desire to settle scores against forest officials. On the whole, no doubt many fires are malicious, but the greater numbers are outcome of carelessness due to ignorance.

B. NATURAL CAUSES

5. **Extreme dry condition and high temperature** during the summer season is congenial for easy and quick ignition of the inflammable dry leaf and other materials through the activities enlisted above to become forest fire, which spreads rapidly being encouraged by the high speed of wind during the said period.



(2) ACTION PLAN FOR 2026: -**(A) PREVENTIVE MEASURES: -****-Crop Burning**

- i. After harvest the remaining portion of the crop in the field are burnt in some cases as a method of disposal and such fire may spread to nearby forest in some places.
- ii. Controlled burning of such fields by the owners in presence of forest staff will prevent possibility of forest fire.

-Mahua Tree Cleaning & collection of Mahua Flower

- i. Block Level Officers shall identify fire-prone Gram Panchayats with a high concentration of Mahua trees and instruct Village Level Workers (VLWs) to sensitize villagers against burning dry leaves, as such fires can rapidly spread to forest areas. Forest Department staff shall undertake leaf removal using fire blowers beneath Mahua trees, as decided in the **Coordination Committee Meeting on Prevention, Control and Management of Forest Fire – 2026 for Mayurbhanj District held on 09.12.2025 under the Chairmanship of the Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj.**
- ii. For easy collection of mahul flowers, villagers very often burn the leaf litter under such mother tree which leads to forest fire.
- iii. To prevent such incidences, controlled burning of the leaf litter under Mahul trees shall be done which would otherwise promote spreading of fire to nearby forest area.
- iv. Such activity can be followed departmentally involving such Mahua flower collectors.

-Bush cutting

- i. Kendu leaf production area is located in Saraskana and Bangriposi Block area of the District, most of the time instead of bush cutting fire work is resorted to get new flush of Kendu leaf. The local people are to be requested to engage them self in bush cutting to get more leaves instead of making fire to Kendu leaves bushes.

-Other Causes

- i. People moving during night hours may carry burning tyre, etc for lamination and leave such harmful substance on forest floor or along road side having dry fallen leaves which lead to spread of fire into forest area. Similarly, smokers carelessly through match sticks or remnants of cigarette or bidi leading to forest fire as stated above.
- ii. For such causes awareness among the people is to be created to remain away from such negligence or carelessness behaviour.

-Rallies, Padayatras, Posters, Videos

- i. Extension approaches through rallies, padayatras, sign boards, use of IEC material like leaflets, banners, etc will help in making awareness among common people regarding causes of forest fire, its adverse effects and various means to prevent and control forest fire.

-Village Oath Taking

- i. Forest vicinity villages play a great role in protection of the forest from fire. Awareness of such communities regarding causes of forest fire, its adverse effects and their responsibility to prevent forest from fire is very important.
- ii. In this regard such village communities are to be motivated to take oath to prevent forest from fire. For this incentives, as admissible, can be given to the village communities who really play a role in preventing forest fire.

-Street Dance, Act, Song, etc.

- i. As a part of awareness programme, street play, songs in local language can be prepared in the best possible manner through which villagers can be motivated to prevent forest from fire.

-Youth Club Activities Plan

- i. In some of the village's youth clubs have been constituted having their social activities along with some socioeconomic programmes. Such youth clubs can be sensitised to play a significant role in preventing forest fire.
- ii. Provision of incentives can be made to those youth clubs which will take responsibility in getting their forest area free from fire attack.

-VSS Activities Plan

- i. Mayurbhanj District has a total number of 952 VSS & 170 EDC in different Ranges. Some of the VSS & EDC's are actively participating on prevention & Control of Forest Fire.
- ii. VSS can play a great role in prevention and protection of forest fire. Hence, the dormant VSS need to be activated by the department so that almost all VSS can come forward to protect forest from fire.
- iii. Communication network of forest department with VSS will be strengthened to make the forest fire prevention drive more effective.
- iv. Beat wise VSS can be organized to involve them in effective forest fire prevention activity.
- v. Provision of reward and incentive can be made to the VSS which will play a significant role in preventing forest fire.

-SHGs Activities Plan

- i. In almost every village woman SHGs have been formed. Their collective efforts make many programs successful.
- ii. Such SHGs can be motivated, organized and strengthened to participate in prevention of forest fire in their village vicinity forest areas.
- vi. Provision of reward and incentive can be made to the SHGs which will play a significant role in preventing forest fire.

-NGOs Activities Plan

- i. At Range level / Section level NGO functionaries can be listed out and out of such list selection of suitable NGOs can be made which can be involved in preventing forest fire.
- ii. The selected NGOs can play a key role in awareness build up programme among the villagers / VSS / SHGs in preventing forest fire.
- iii. Provision of incentives & fund for other related programmes can be made departmentally for such NGOs to organize forest fire preventive measures.

-NSS / NCC Camps / Meeting in villages

- i. Local School level and College level NSS / NCC camps can be made in forest vicinity villages and through their awareness meeting programmes villagers / SHG members can be sensitized in prevention of forest fire.
- ii. Provision of incentives & fund for other related programmes can be made departmentally for such NSS / NCC Camps to organize forest fire preventive measures.

- GP Meeting on 3F- Panchayat

- i. Beat wise / Section wise Gram Panchayats can be listed out along with the information on the forest areas / blocks in respect of each such GP.
- ii. GP meetings can be organized to sensitize the villagers / SHGs / village level communities to participate in prevention of fire in their village vicinity forest areas.
- vi. Provision of reward and incentive can be made to the GPs which will play a significant role in preventing forest fire

- Preparation of Fire lines

- i. Fire line also called fire break is the practice of clearing a strip of vegetation at a width of 3mts over the land so that if there's fire, the fire flames do not spread.
- ii. Fire lines are prepared/maintained during winter, it starts from the month of January and continues upto February every year.

-Dos and Don't List on Prevention & control of Forest Fire- in Annexure-II

(B) Mitigative Measures: -

-24X7 Control Room Functioning

- i. 24X7 Control Room headed by an Officer of Deputy Ranger / Forester shall function at Division office level to collect information on forest fire incidences, record it, transmit to Range, Section and Beat for immediate action. The control room shall be supported with staff and equipment to make it able to discharge its responsibility in Forest Fire Protection assignment.
- ii. The control room shall ensure Registration of official Mobile number with FSI website (<http://www.fsi.org.in>) for getting fire alert message and set up effective two-way communication network.
- iii. Contact number of control room shall be displayed at Beat, Section and Range Offices.
- iv. The control room shall monitor prevention of forest fire, extent of forest fire, affects due to forest fire and control measures to be taken to mitigate the effects.
- v. From the control room detail information will be transmitted to State headquarters.
- vi. The division level control room shall be provided with man power and other facilities like cell phone, VHF network, records for effective communication, monitoring and documentation.
- vii. Such control rooms shall also function at each Range level.

-Manpower and Equipment Deployment Plan

- i. At different important places / strategic points of the Range Forest Fire Protection squad shall be deployed.
- ii. Each Fire protection squad shall function under the leadership of a responsible Forester / Forest Guard.

- iii. Vehicle will be made available for movement of Fire protection squads.
- iv. Fire protection equipments like blowers, extinguishers and other such items shall be made available with each squad.
- v. Duty registers and log book shall be maintained for the squads and staffs of the Range.

-Training of Squads and VSS members on operation of blowers and safety measures

- i. Squad persons and VSS members shall be given proper training with assistance of fire service personnel for effective fire control.
- ii. Mock drill training shall be organised in coordination with Fire service officers for forest department staff, Fire protection squad, VSS members on use of fire-fighting equipment for effective means of forest fire control.
- iii. Such training will also include safe custody of firefighting equipment and kits.

-Police Support in booking cases on Forest Fire

- i. In cases of forest offence relating to deliberately causing forest fire, expeditious steps shall be taken to initiate legal action against culprits with due procedure and adequate evidence.
- ii. For such legal action, wherever necessary, local police support shall be taken.
- iii. In the division level and Range level coordination meetings, Police officials shall be invited to participate.

-Fire Service support for combating forest fire

- i. At Division Level and Range Level Coordination meetings shall be organised with District level and Sub-Divisional / Block level Fore Officers along with other line department officers on prevention and control of forest fire.
- ii. The Range Officers and Foresters shall keep close contact with local Fire Service Station for information, technical guidance and physical assistance to combat forest fire.

-Sarapanchas may be delegated with powers to apprehend persons causing Forest Fire

- i. Division wise Forest Fire control room are now functional at each division of forest division of Mayurbhanj district to receive the fire alerts through FSI and staff of various ranges. The details of the control room being operated is enclosed as **(Anexture-V)**

-ST / SC Department and Tribal religious leaders may help in motivating the tribal to do the traditional activities relating to forest fire.

-Procurement of sufficient blowers and kits (Jackets, shoes, etc) for squads

- i. At Division level, requirement of firefighting equipment and tools shall be procured for strengthening the Ranges including Sections and Beats.
- ii. All the Divisional Forest Officers and Range Officers shall ensure all equipments required for fighting have been supplied to all Forest Guards, VSS members, Firefighting squads and are in working condition.

-District Support Allocations

Co-ordination meeting will be held with Chief Development Officer-cum- Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Mayurbhanj & PRI in order to ascertain scope of allocation from such Departments towards District Forest Fire Prevention & Management purpose.

-Support of Other Line Departments

Co-ordination meeting will be held with Other Line Departments in order to ascertain scope of allocation from such Departments towards District Forest Fire Prevention & Management purpose.

-Non-Budgetary Support Activities

Co-ordination meeting will be held with Odisha Fire Service and Other such Departments to find out the scope regarding Non-Budgetary Support Activities for the purpose of Prevention and Control of Forest Fire.

1.Chief Development Officer-cum- Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Mayurbhanj

- a) The Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj District advised all Sub-Collectors, Mayurbhanj to conduct Block-level awareness meetings in vulnerable Gram Panchayats located in fire-prone areas during February 2026.
- b) The Panchayat Officers (POs), Assistant Development Officers (ADOs), and Gram Rozgar Sevaks (GRSs) are to actively conduct ground-level meetings and create awareness among villagers regarding forest fire prevention and control measures.
- c) The Block Level Officers are to identify fire-prone Gram Panchayats having a high concentration of Mahua trees and to direct Village Level Workers (VLWs) to sensitize villagers not to set fire to dry leaves, as such practices often lead to the rapid spread of forest fires. Rather staff of Forest Department are to use fire blower to clean the leaves below the Mahua tree.
- d) The District Education Officer (DEO) and District Welfare Officer (DWO), Mayurbhanj are to distribute forest fire awareness leaflets supplied by the Forest Department among students and parents.

2. Police Department

Police Department has to provide necessary police assistance to the Forest Officers as and when required for the purpose to combat any unwanted situation and to extend his support in booking of cases against the offenders involved in forest fire as per the provision U/s 27(1)(b),3(a) of Odisha Forest Act 1972. He suggested that concerned Forest Range Officers should contact the concerned IIC of Police in their counterpart to cooperate in detection of Forest Fire related offence cases as and when required.

3.District Education Officer (D.E.O)

District Education Officer to conduct awareness programme on Forest Fire in coordination with the forest department to create awareness among the students of the schools living in the forest fringe villages. 855 Nos of Eco-clubs are in the districts the list of the Eco-Club School has been supplied to the District Education Officer and was requested to take up capacity building training at Block Levels involving Block Education Officer and Eco-club teachers of the schools.

4.District Welfare Officer (DWO)

District Welfare Officer, Mayurbhanj to conduct awareness meeting on Forest Fire among the Eco-club school and other schools living in the forest fringe area by way of creating awareness and other forms to reach the public with the Forest Department and to create awareness among the students of the schools.

5.District Social Welfare Officer (DSWO)

The District Social Welfare Officer DSWO Mayurbhanj to take up awareness programme among the SHG Groups, Anganbadi Workers and organize awareness programme on Forest Fire in the forest fringe villages.

6.District Sports Officer, Mayurbhanj

The District Sports Officer was advised to organize sports activities such as football and cricket tournaments, in coordination with the Forest Department, with the trophy/theme dedicated to **FOREST FIRE** prevention awareness.

D- Non-Budgetary Support Activities.

Forest Department

Around 130 villages which are prone to forest fire as well as vulnerable for poaching shall be selected in and around Similipal Tiger Reserve and shall be participating in the above programme. The villages spreading over 05 Divisions of this District will be involved in this programme. An awareness rally in the form of Cycling Yatra, Pada Yatra (Marathon) shall be conducted from one village to another village aimed at preventing forest fire, where the local village leaders shall be involved apart from the officials of Line Departments. The list of 130 villages Division wise & Range wise is provided in (**Annexure-III.**)

(5) CONCLUSION: -

-Concomitant Monitoring

Day to day monitoring of prevention and control of forest fire at Division level, Range level, Section level and beat level will be followed to get a fruitful result. This will also follow documentation which will help in coming years in mitigating forest fire.

-Expected Outcome

The comprehensive District Action Plan 2026 regarding Forest Fire Prevention and Management will have a great impact upon prevention and control of forest fire in all the five forest divisions of the district. Experience from implementation of this will help in future management of forest fire prevention in the district. Once forest fire is effectively controlled, the regeneration status and growing stock of the forest resource will certainly improve in future.

ANNEXURE-II**Do's and Don'ts to prevent Forest Fires****Dos**

1. Inform the local forest guard immediately if you notice any fire in and around forests. The contact numbers are displayed at prominent public places.
2. You can also use the telephone numbers given below to report an incidence of a forest fire.
3. Do also report the jointforest management committee about the occurrence of forest fires.
4. Help the forest guards and joint forest management committee in fighting and controlling the fires.
5. Conduct meetings and promote the advantages of forests at various places.
6. Prepare measures to prevent fires and stop the spreading of fires and inform others.
7. Do take precautions during fighting forest fires. Don't be a victim of a forest fire.
8. Raw tree branches as an emergency measure can be used to control thefires.
9. Draw a line by clearing dry leaves and tree branches. This line will prevent the fire to spread further.
10. Inform others that putting forests on fire is a punishable offence.

Don'ts

1. Don't ignite fires in forests. It is a punishable offence and you could face jail or fine or both.
2. Don't carry combustible and inflammable objects like atchboxes, gunpowder, and firecrackers inside forests.
3. Don't smoke in the forest. Your negligence can cause a wildfire.
4. Don't put the forest on fire for the purpose of preparing charcoal. Strictly avoid this.
5. Don't put the tree roots on fire whilecollecting forest products like Mahula, Tola etc.
6. Don't use explosives and fireworks in and around a forest.
7. Fire is the main enemy of the forest. Don't light fires in forests.

ANNEXURE-IV**Proceeding of the Coordination Meeting on Prevention & Control of Forest Fire and Management District Action Plan 2026****PROCEEDINGS OF THE COORDINATION COMMITTEE MEETING ON PREVENTION, CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF FOREST FIRE-2026 OF MAYURBHANJ DISTRICT HELD ON 09.12.2025 AT 01.30 PM IN THE MAHATMA GANDHI CONFERENCE HALL OF THE COLLECTORATE, BARIKATA**

A meeting of the District Coordination Committee on Forest Fire Prevention, Control and Management- 2026 was held on 09.12.2025 at 01:30 PM in the Mahatma Gandhi Conference Hall, Collectorate, Baripada, under the Chairmanship of the Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj.

The meeting was attended by the Field Director, Similipal Tiger Reserve-cum-Regional Chief Conservator of Forests, Baripada Circle, all District Level Officers, and other stakeholders. The list of officers present is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

The District Education Officer, Mayurbhanj and District Welfare Officer, Mayurbhanj neither attended the meeting nor deputed any representative, despite communication issued vide this office letter No. 9998 dated 08.12.2025. The Chair expressed displeasure over this lapse.

At the outset, the Divisional Forest Officer, Baripada welcomed all participants and briefed the committee on the preparedness for the ensuing forest fire season and forest fire management strategy for the year 2026 in Mayurbhanj District.

Based on the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), an Action Plan for Forest Fire Management - 2026 was prepared and presented by the DFO through a PowerPoint presentation.

The Field Director, Similipal Tiger Reserve-cum-RCCF, Baripada Circle highlighted the successful implementation of the AI-based camera surveillance system during the previous year. It was informed that the AI-enabled system detected fire points at an early stage, facilitating prompt response and effective containment. This proactive detection mechanism significantly contributed to the reduction of forest fire incidents across the Similipal Biosphere Reserve.

The Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj, while emphasizing the objective of achieving zero forest fire incidents in the district, actively participated in the deliberations and issued the following directions:

Decisions Taken / Instructions Issued

- a) The Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj District advised all Sub-Collectors, Mayurbhanj to conduct Block-level awareness meetings in vulnerable Gram Panchayats located in fire-prone areas during February 2026.
- b) The Panchayat Officers (POs), Assistant Development Officers (ADOs), and Gram Rozgar Sevaks (GRSs) are to actively conduct ground-level meetings and create awareness among villagers regarding forest fire prevention and control measures.
- c) The Block Level Officers are to identify fire-prone Gram Panchayats having a high concentration of Mahua trees and to direct Village Level Workers (VLWs) to sensitize villagers not to set fire to dry leaves, as such practices often lead to the rapid spread of forest fires. Rather staff of Forest Department are to use fire blower to clean the leaves below the Mahua tree.
- d) The District Education Officer (DEO) and District Welfare Officer (DWO), Mayurbhanj are to distribute forest fire awareness leaflets supplied by the Forest Department among students and parents.

- e) Village level workers in fire prone Gram Panchayats, in co-ordination with local forest staff are to make awareness programme in fringe villages to forest block about the spread of fire to forest due to fire to paddy thrash and convince them not to fire the waste thresh but for control burning of thrash and Sabai grass stumps. Advice to give incentive to the informer intimating the incident of forest fire(keeping the name of informer hidden) with location and offender causing the fire.
- f) Mass awareness programme against forest fire should be conducted at School and Collages level. Local PRI members, SHGs, VSSs, Anganwadi Workers are to be included in such awareness programme. The parents of the students and other members present are to be requested for oath taking to protect forest fire putting their signature.
- g) The Collector and District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj announced the district-level individual award, to be conferred every year from **January 2026**, titled **"Protection in Forest Fire"**:
- The award shall be conferred on residents of Mayurbhanj District who actively participate in forest fire awareness and prevention activities in the district.
- h) It was also decided to organize a Cycle Rally jointly by the Forest Department and District Administration to create mass awareness against forest fires. The proposed route of the rally will be from Baripada to Devkund.
- i) The District Sports Officer was advised to organize sports activities such as football and cricket tournaments, in coordination with the Forest Department, with the trophy/theme dedicated to **FOREST FIRE** prevention awareness.
- j) The Chair also advised to organize and promote short documentary films on forest fire management and prevention through social media platforms to enhance consequences of forest fire public outreach and awareness.
- k) Mass awareness programme through street dance and song on local language for protecting forest fire.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Baripada expressed his appreciation for the mock drill exercises conducted by the Odisha Fire Service Department staff in previous years and informed that similar mock drills are to be also conducted during the current year.

The DFO, Baripada presented the details of mock drill exercises and training programmes proposed to be organized across five Forest Divisions of Mayurbhanj District, as detailed below:

The DFO informed that one Control Room in each Forest Division is functioning round-the-clock (24x7) at the respective Divisional Offices. One Assistant Conservator of Forests (ACF) has been designated as the Nodal Officer for each Control Room and entrusted with monitoring and addressing all issues related to forest fire management.

He also presented the details of fire lines proposed to be created and maintained in all five Forest Divisions, as given below:

The DFO further informed that 855 Eco-Clubs are actively functioning in Mayurbhanj District, and these Eco-Clubs are to be sensitized to organize various awareness programmes on forest fire prevention in their respective localities.

He also presented the details of fire-prone villages in the district and emphasized the involvement of all line department officers and stakeholders to carry out intensive awareness and preventive activities in the 734 identified fire-prone villages before the onset of the forest fire season.

The Superintendent of Police, Mayurbhanj assured full police assistance to Forest Officers as and when required to combat any untoward situations related to forest fires. He also extended support for booking of cases against offenders involved in forest fire incidents under the provisions of Section 27(1)(b), 3(a) of the Odisha Forest Act, 1972.

He further advised that the concerned Forest Range Officers should maintain close coordination with the respective Inspectors-in-Charge (IICs) of local Police Stations for prompt detection and investigation of forest fire-related offences.

The meeting concluded with a **vote of thanks** to the Chair and all officers present.




