The ITP is for a period of eighteen (18) months starting from 15.06.2026 to 14.12.2027. 



The Telangana State Forest Academy is located on the Hyderabad-Nagpur National High way No. 7, in the serene surroundings of Dulapally Reserve Forest near Dulapally village at a distance of 24 km from Hyderabad city. The location offers an ideal atmosphere for conducting training and educational activities. Secunderabad Railway Station is at a distance of 20 km (45 minutes) and Rajiv Gandhi International Airport is 50 km (60 minutes drive).

Weather Report: Hyderabad experiences a tropical wet and dry climate with three main seasons: hot summers (March-June, up to 45°C), a moderate monsoon (July-October), and mild winters (November-February, 13-30°C). The city is generally pleasant and warm year-round, with dry, sunny, or partially cloudy conditions, punctuated by heavy rains during the monsoon season

ARRIVAL:

Trainees should report **positively one day before the commencement of the course i.e. on 14th June, 2026** at Telangana State Forest Academy. The course will commence as soon as the trainees are enrolled and in no case the admission will be permitted after **15th June, 2026**.

ACCOMMODATION:

All trainees will be accommodated in the Academy Hostel and they shall reside in the Hostel and abide by the Hostel Rules and the Director's standing orders from time to time.

Note: After their arrival in the Academy, extra dress items of prescribed pattern will be provided from their equipment allowance.

Deposits: In addition to the tuition fee and other training expenses, all candidates will be required to deposit the following amounts themselves to cover the initial expenditure at the Academy -

i) Caution money	:	Rs. 10,000/-
ii) Mess advance	:	Rs. 5,000/-
Total	:	Rs. 15,000/-

Note:- Caution money is refundable on completion of the course after making deductions for losses and breakages etc., if any. Mess will be managed by trainees themselves as cooperative mess.

GENERAL:

All the trainees will have to obey the following Instructions during the entire Training Course period -

1. Trainees are required to strictly conform to uniform/dress regulations and discipline of the Academy.
 - i) Class Room Dress Code - Khaki pant, Khaki shirt, Khaki socks, Brown Shoes
 - ii) In P.T & Games- White short*, White T-shirt, White Socks and White Canvas Shoes
 - iii) In Mess - Gray Pant, White Shirt with Tie, Black Socks, Black Shoes

(*Lady Officers should wear white trouser instead of white shorts)

2. It is mandatory for all the trainees to attend Classes in the timings mentioned below-

Classes	9:00AM to 1:00PM
	2:00PM to 4:00PM

3. Physical Training and Games are compulsory to build physical strength, endurance and good health, which are pre-requisites for a successful and efficient Forest Officer.

PT	:	6:00 AM to 6:45 AM
Games	:	5:00 PM to 6:00 PM

4. The trainees are required to take up and complete One Seminar Project work on any field level Forest Management issue during the Course of their training period.

Field work / Seminar Project work : on Saturdays

Mentor - Mentee meeting : on Sunday at 10:00 AM

5. It is mandatory for all trainees to reside in the Academy hostel and join the Academy mess. The timings for mess are as follows.

Breakfast	08:00 AM to 08:45 AM
Lunch	01:00 PM to 02:00 PM
Dinner	08:00 PM to 09:00 PM

6. All trainees are allowed for outing on Sunday and Holidays subject to exigencies of training course, while residing at the headquarters. The timings for outing are as below :

On Sundays & Holidays	11:00 AM to 08:00 PM
Working days after games	6:30 -8:00 PM

7. Candidates are not allowed to go outside the Academy premises except on the days and hours notified by the Hostel Warden/Course Director/Director.
8. No visitor will be allowed to reside in the Hostel without the permission of the Director.
9. Keeping of pets and car, motor cycle, scooter/scooty, fire arms, knife, etc. are forbidden in the hostel.
10. Trainees are liable to pay for any breakage or loss of stores, fittings and equipments.
11. The trainees who are habitually wearing spectacles should bring an extra pair to avoid any inconvenience in case of some breakage of their spectacles, while at Headquarters or on tours.
12. The trainees shall also carry their personal medications, if any.
13. Each trainee should give three copies of their **passport size photographs positively on the day of joining** to the Officer incharge so that identity cards can be issued.
14. They must be in possession of sufficient money to purchase other required materials which may not be covered by the Equipment Allowance sanctioned. The trainees are well advised not to possess heavy cash with them during the stay in this Academy. State Bank of India branch Dulapally has ATM Facility and they are advised to deposit their extra money in the Bank Account as a measure of safety.
15. Trainees shall be required to take their meals at the Academy mess. Meals will not be allowed in the living rooms except in case of illness and with prior permission of Warden /Director.

16. During the term of training, no trainee shall leave head quarters without the permission of the Director nor shall any trainee, while in camp, leave the camp headquarters without written order of the officer-in-charge who shall intimate such absence to the Director.
 17. The trainees are given mid-term vacation of 30 days during which time they will also have to undergo a Range attachment in their state for a minimum period of one week. **No leave will be granted in general.** Only in exceptional cases very short leave may be granted by the Competent Authority/Course Director.
 18. Exemption from P.T. & Games will not be allowed. Only in exceptional cases like illness, exemption may be allowed by the Competent Authority/Course Director.


