



Preliminary Instruction and Information for the Range Officer Trainees of 2026-2027 Batch of Odisha Forest Rangers' College, Angul.

1. LOCATION OF THE COLLEGE

Odisha Forest Rangers College is situated at Angul town at a distance of about 120 km from Bhubaneswar. The Town is well connected by bus and railway with major towns of Odisha. The College campus is located at a distance of about 200 Mtrs from the Angul Bus Stand and 2.5 km from Angul railway Station.

2. ARRIVAL:

The session will commence from dt.15.06.2026 Fore Noon. Trainees should arrange to arrive at Odisha Forest Ranger's College, Angul well in advance so that they may report in the college at 09:30 A.M. on dt.14.06.2026. No relaxation of time/date may be allowed.

3. ADMISSION:

Every Trainee shall fill up the ADMISSION FORM and submit the same together with the following certificates (Original and self attested photo copies) at the time of reporting on 14.06.2026. (Date of Registration: 15.06.2026 Time: 10.00 AM Venue: Mooney Auditorium Hall, Odisha Forest Rangers' College, Angul).

- (i) Original copy of Offer Letter issued by the GOVT.
- (ii) Certificate of age (HSC/ICSE/CBSE examination certificate).
- (iii) Bachelors Degree Certificate.
- (iv) Photo copy of Aadhar Card.
- (v) Photo copy of PAN Card.
- (vi) Certificate of Health issued by State Medical Board (SMB).
- (vii) Three recent colour Passport photographs self attested.
- (viii) Non pregnancy certificate of the ladies trainees issued by any Govt. Hospital.
- (ix) Photo copies of the Bank details of the Trainees with IFSC Code.
- (x) Undertaking form.

Unless the documents mentioned above are produced, the Trainees may not be admitted in to the College. The trainees will be admitted into the College only when it is verified that they confirm to the requirements under the College rules and that they have deposited the required fees indicated in SI no.14 .

4. DURATION OF THE TRAINING:

As per the extant provisions of Entrance and Training Rules (Revised), 2004 for Forest Range Officers and letter No.3-17/99/RT dt.21.06.2004, F.No.3-17/99-RT(pt) dt.10.01.2006 and F.No.3-17/99-RT(pt) dt.04.01.2010 of Deputy Inspector General of Forests (RT), Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests (Research and Training Division) issued by Director Forest Education, Govt.of India , the Induction Training is for 18 months.

5. ACCOMMODATION:

All students will be provided accommodation in the College Hostels and will have to remain in the hostel throughout the training period. They will have to abide by the rules of the hostel. Residing in the hostel is mandatory. The trainees will not be permitted to keep their families/pets/personal vehicle in the OFRC campus. After 09.00 PM no trainee is allowed to remain outside the hostel campus except due to emergency with prior permission of the Director, OFRC, Angul.

6. MESS:

All the Trainees who will be admitted in to the college will have their food in the college mess. The officer trainees will manage their own mess in the college hostel through a mess committee. The mess committee will be comprised of one mess manager and one trainee from each state representing. Every day mess will be looked after by one Mess Duty Officer from among the trainees. Each trainee has to look after the mess as a MDO as per their roll no. All trainees shall be required to take their meals in the mess which would cater both vegetarian and non vegetarian food. The trainees are required to clear their mess and other dues punctually at the end of every month. Every trainee shall be required to enter his name in block letters with the date of joining in the mess register kept in the dining hall.

7. PHYSICAL TRAINING:

Every day PT, Shramdan and Games & Sports sessions will be done in the morning (05.00 AM in summer and 06.00 AM in winter months) and evening (5:30 PM in summer and 4:30 PM in winter) respectively for a period of two hours. It is compulsory for every student to attend the PT and games classes.

8. CLASSROOM SESSION:

Regular class (Pre lunch session) will start at 10.00 AM in the morning and continue till 01:15 PM with a tea break of 15 min. at 11.30 AM. After lunch, the classes will start at 02:15 PM and continue till 04:15 PM. The lunch time will be for duration of one hour, i.e from 01:15 PM to 02:15 PM. All trainees (except Mess duty officer of the said day) should attend the class compulsorily. **Trainees whose attendance at the college falls below 80% shall not be permitted to appear in the exam.**

9. TOUR:

There shall be 5(five) major tours during the entire period of training. Besides this, the trainees will be taken to different parts of Odisha as well as to different parts of the country on tour to have an idea and knowledge of the Forest and Wildlife of the State. Entire tour period is 145 days which would cover the practical aspects of the training. Field exercises on Road alignment, engineering, working plan and ecological census technique will be covered during the course. **Performance of the trainees will be assessed during the tour and field exercise by conducting tour exam and marks will be awarded.** In the addition, training on motor vehicle, use of weapons, swimming and first aid will also be imparted. **Any trainee who misses more than 10% of any tour shall have to repeat the missed portion unless exempted by the Director, OFRC, Angul.** Weekly field tour will be conducted on Sunday. No trainee is allowed to remain absent/ on leave during the training period.

10. EXAMINATION:

There shall be two examinations at the end of first and second phase as per the Entrance & Training Rules (Revised) 2004 for Forest Range Officers issued by Director, Forestry Education, Dehradun, Govt. of India. Besides term tour, exam will be conducted after every tour and each trainees has to submit tour journal and botanical collection. Marks will be awarded based on the performance in tour exam, journal, symposium, quiz test and botanical sample collection. **Any trainee securing less than 50% marks in a subject will be considered to have been failed in the subject.** Trainees who have failed will have to appear in supplementary examination to be conducted at the end of first or second phase, as the case may be. Marks originally obtained in the subject will be counted towards his/her merit. If he/ she again fails in more than 3(Three) subjects the trainee will be sent back to the sponsoring authority.

GENERAL EQUIPMENTS:

The training includes extensive field visits. Every trainee should equip himself with the articles listed in the ANNEXURE-1 before joining the college alongwith other necessities for staying in the hostel and for training.

12. DRESS CODE:

During the entire period of training at the College, all the officer trainees shall adhere to the prescribed college dress code. They should maintain a smart turn out and appear properly dressed at all times. The dress code inside campus will be khaki uniform (Both for Ladies and Gents).

- a) Formal Full Pants
- b) Formal Shirt full sleeved with shoulder flaps and chest pockets

During PT and games the uniform will be white sports shirt (T-Shirt) and white half pants for Gents and white sports shirt with white full track pant for Ladies. At other times the Gents trainees are expected to be dressed in white full pant and shirt and the ladies will be in white salwar kamiz and dupatta inside the campus. The trainees shall always keep themselves clean & well dressed. The trainees will be required to purchase the barrette cap and belt with logo of OFRC. The trainees shall wear olive green woolen jackets/pullover during the winter.

13. GENERAL CONDUCT:

Every trainee should maintain proper discipline and conduct both inside and outside campus which will be counted towards their conduct mark. Any type of misconduct will be seriously viewed and it may lead to expulsion from the Institute. Marks will be awarded to each trainee based on their overall conduct by each faculty which will be counted towards merit.

14. INITIAL EXPENDITURE:

Every student should bring with him/her at least the following amount of money to meet the initial expenditures.

1.	College caution money to be deposited at the time of admission and refundable at the end of the course	Rs.10000/- (In shape of Demand Draft in favour of Director, Forestry Training, Odisha Forest Rangers' College, Angul Payable at State Bank of India, Angul Branch.
2.	Mess advance to be deposited with the Officer in charge of the mess. (This amount is either adjustable/refundable at the end of the course)	Rs.10000/-

15. GENERAL INSTRUCTION:

- (a) Every married female trainee should come with a non pregnancy certificate issued from Govt. Hospital as the 18 month Induction Course Training in comprises of mandatory physical, class room and field tour sessions which cannot be completed on/during pregnancy and ultimately leads to cancellation of candidature from the ongoing Induction training course.
- (b) Trainees are not allowed to keep pets while undergoing the training course.
- (c) Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the class room and during exam.
- (d) Fire arms, expensive gadgets and Record players are not permissible in the Hostel. The trainees wearing glasses should carry two pair of the same, so that the same can be used in case of accidental breakage.
- (e) Consuming alcohol, smoking & chewing tobacco or taking any kind of drug etc. is strictly prohibited, any body found using the same will be dealt as per the extant legal provision such as repatriation from the training on administrative and disciplinary ground.
- (f) Trainees are directed to maintain and respect the local culture. Any deviation shall be treated as Indiscipline and necessary disciplinary action will be taken.
