

Permanent Nursery, Bamanda


The vision of Forest Department 2020 envisages improving Forest and tree cover of the State by planting more and more trees. Quality Planting Material (QPM) is an essential and mandatory input for raising successful plantations.

The success of a plantation programme depends to a great extent on success of nursery which is the foundation of plantation. Bighnaraj Permanent Nursery, Bamanda was established as per guidelines prescribed during the year 2015 with project cost of Rs. 2.38 crore under EAMPA is unique to its type.

Earlier the site was barren, infertile without any use and there was threat of encroachment. Total area is 76.59 Acs. of Jungal Kisaam, now covered with 10, 000 nos. plant under Urban Plantation 2015-16, Outside Working Plan Plantation of 2015-16 over 7 Ha. and the nursery of 6.25 Ha. resulting reclamation of the area and increasing green cover in TOF.

Attempt was made the make the site an education hub and traditional knowledge center for local people and students. Under District Environment Society (DES) Nakshtra van & Nabagraha Vatika was established to create awareness and attachment of people towards protection and conservation of some important rare, endangered and threatened species:

All most all components of the nursery was found place at appropriate places and priority was imparted to local indigenous species. Excellent quality planting materials, medicinal & aromatic plants, ecotourism and seed stand of plus trees are the luture programme is on the way.


