PREFACE



Forestry sector is becoming more and more challenging with each passing year. The job of a forest officer is getting increasingly difficult in the backdrop of ever increasing population pressure on our forests and growing needs of natural resources for the society. Man-animal conflict is on the rise. Conservation vs. Development debate does not seem to die. In such a scenario, our field foresters continue to render yeoman's service to the society. Most of the time, they have to wriggle out of intricate situations by providing solutions to different stakeholders in the society. This will act as a treasure of cherished memories for the recipients, their near and dear ones and all others associated with the function. Smt. Jayshree Murmu

Forest Range Officer Range : Barkote

Division: Deogarh Forest

Smt. Jayshree Murmu, Range Officer, Barkote Range of Deogarh Forest Division has done excellent job in the field of forest protection, afforestation and wildlife management. She was responsible for booking 4 no. of PR cases related to wildlife resulting in seizure of 2 elephant tusks. She also took great interest in rescue and release of 2 no. of piglets. She was successful in arresting the accused person by utilizing the pictures captured in the camera trap. She has conducted 10 no. of house search, submitted 17 no. of PR cases, 468 no. of OR cases and seizure of 12 no. of motorized vehicle. As an example of convergence activity with animal husbandry department, she was responsible for construction of solar powered water tank at Remalasahi under Swajal Dhara scheme for the development of Paudi Bhuyan community. She was also responsible for large no of awareness meeting for the prevention of forest fire.



Sri Sidhartha Sankar Sahu, Forest Range Officer, Khallikote Range has been showing outstanding performance in forest protection, Joint Forest Management (JFM), Afforestation activities, Wildlife protection & management during his tenure in Khallikote Range of Berhampur Forest Division from September, 2020 to December, 2021 for which he been chosen for State Forestry Award. Sri Sahu has shown outstanding performance in the field of forest protection in most critical areas including seizure of illegal timber trading as well as unauthorized fishing trawlers during sea patrolling. He was responsible for arrest and prosecution of 14 no. of accused persons and seizure of large quantity of sandalwood. Improvement in forest growth and development has been noticed in Khallikote Range during his tenure. He has successfully taken up various modules of afforestation with indigenous species that led to increase in forest cover. He has contributed significantly to the development of wildlife habitat especially in the case of blackbuck.

Sri Ananta Charan Parida, Forester has worked with full devotion in different Ranges of Keonjhar Wildlife Division . During his tenure in the mobile squad, he detected and seized as many as 10 vehicles with forest produce and also wildlife articles. He gave his best effort in relocating 95 families in first phase and 75 families in 2nd phase from different villages of Hadagarh WL Sanctuary. He has raised successful plantation in Green Mahanadi Mission, Avenue plantation, and MGNREGA. Through awareness programmes he has checked poaching of wildlife and prevented forest fire in the forest fringe areas of his section. In the interest of wild animals, he has maintained grass land and various saltlicks. He is a sincere, obedient and dedicated front line field staff. His effort in relocation of villagers from Pitanau area of Hadagarh WL Sanctuary is commendable. He has proved himself as an asset to the forest department.



Sri Dhoba Rana, Forester in Deogaon (KL) Range of Titilagarh (KL) Division has done excellent work in the field of production and processing of Kendu leaves. He has consistently achieved the target of KL production at a very reasonable rate of Kerry consumption. The level of Padta achieved is commendable. Such achievement was possible only because of high level of skill and acumen acquired by him. Because of his sincerity and dedication he was able to achieve a very high value of average sale price. This achievement becomes more remarkable as average sale price has been consistently recording high value. This is a great indicator of quality processing, binding and bagging of Kendu Leaves. This also reflects the high level of trust reposed by Kendu Leaves purchasers in the ability of Sri Dhoba Rana and his supporting staff. Such persons are valuable assets to the Kendu Leaves wing of Forest Department.

Smt. Kalpana Kumari Pradhan, Forester of Ghumsur South Division has achieved great performance in the field of forest protection, wildlife management and Joint Forest Management (JFM). She was responsible for 4 no. of PR cases, 304 no of OR cases and seizure of large quantities of timber, firewood and bamboo. She also played significant role in forest raids, house search and seizure of 4 no. of motorized vehicle. In the field of participatory forest management, she was responsible for the formation of 12 no. of VSS after conducting 56 no. of meetings. Due to her sincere efforts the survival percentage in the plantations raised by her during the current year is 100%. She was also responsible for rescue and release of 5 no. of black bucks. Enjoying the confidence of her superior authorities, she has performed efficiently, there by proving to be an asset for the Ghumsur (S) Division.



Sri Ranjan Kumar Jit, Forester of Badrama Wildlife Range under Bamra Wildlife Division is an active, dynamic, diligent, obedient and dedicated forest staff. His works in protection of forest from illicit felling, forest fire, conservation of wildlife from poaching, care and treatment of rescued and distressed animals, their release and restoration in the forests, interest in participation and co-ordination in various wildlife census programmes and research activities are remarkable and praiseworthy. He is responsible for 8 no. of PR cases, 150 no. of OR cases and seizure of large quantities of timber, bamboo, firewood and kendu leaves. He has also seized 7 no. of motorized vehicles. His efforts in forest regeneration and awareness campaign for conservation of nature and natural resources and through EDC members under JFM framework are also commendable. His works have resulted in the reduction of dependency of local communities on forests of Badrama Wildlife Sanctuary.



Sri Sibananda Lenka

Sri Sibananda Lenka, Forester is a sincere hard working forest staff. He has recently rescued one crocodile in the village Sadashivpur and one sloth bear in the village MV-20. He has shown great interest in promoting Joint Forest Management with the help of VSS members. He has been instrumental in raising different variety of rice and forestry species in the private fields of local villagers in Balimela NAC. As a result he has become very popular in his area. He has also persuaded the villagers to use organic manure in place of chemical fertilizers. Such works have been highly appreciated by the common people. Sri Lenka has carried out successful plantation under various schemes like urban /economic/ avenue plantation and Miyawaki / CAMPA. He has taken keen interest in raising forestry species especially local varieties in Balimela area. He has developed traditional techniques for preparation of organic insecticides and manures also.



Sri Sibanarayan Majhi, Forester is hard working sincere and responsible forest staff. In spite of working in a difficult and sensitive district his contribution in the field of protection, anti-smuggling measures and anti-poaching squad has been commendable. He has been conducting regular foot patrolling and preventing forest fire inside the sanctuary which is a very rich wildlife habitat. Sri Majhi has been interacting regularly with the members of Eco-Development Committee thereby promoting the movement of joint forest management. He has taken various steps for eviction of encroachers and prevention of illegal constructions inside the sanctuary. His contribution towards forest and wildlife management is praiseworthy. His performance in the field of afforestation activities is also of highest order. He has taken special care to plant fruit trees keeping in mind the food habits of wild animals found in the sanctuary. Sri Majhi has also motivated the villagers to dissuade them from Akhand Shikar.



Sri Ananda Bihari Swain

Forest Guard

Ananda Bihari Swain, Forest Guard, of Bolangir Forest Division contributed a lot towards protection of the forest through awareness in different forest fringe villages. His proactive attitude in dealing with forest fire is praiseworthy. As many as 202 no. of cases have been booked by him during 2021-2022 seizing 4.9 cum of timber, 97.5 q. of firewood and 980 no. of poles. He is always very cordial with the general public and he has conducted more than 70 VSS meetings during the year 2021-2022. He is found to possess scientific approach in plantation activities and has raised many successful plantations. In the field of wildlife management he was responsible for rescue and release of 1 barking deer and 1 golden eagle. He has been especially trained in camera trapping for tiger and other wild animals. He is truly an asset to the forest department.



Sri Deepak Ranjan Pattanayak, Forest Guard, of Balliguda Forest Division has done very good work in the field of forest protection, wildlife management and Joint Forest management. He has ensured regular patrolling in his area as a result of which the wild animals have got complete protection from poachers. He was also responsible for rescue and release of 1 pangolin and 1 spotted deer. He is responsible for 4 no. of PR cases, 67 no. of OR cases and seizure of large amount of forest produce. He also participated in large no of forest raids resulting in seizure of motorized vehicles. Regarding his performance in JFM, he is responsible for the formation of 5 no. of VSS and large no. of awareness meetings for prevention of forest fire. His performance in the field of afforestation has been very good and the survival percentage in the plantations raised by him is above 95%.



Sri Naresh Kumar Sethi

Forest Guard

Range : Kaptipada

Division: Baripada Forest

Shri Naresh Kumar Sethi, Forest Guard has been doing excellent work in Similipal Tiger Reserve area. Notto reserve forest which lies in his jurisdiction of Sarat beat is an important link between Hadgarh wildlife sanctuary and Similipal Tiger Reserve. Sri Sethi has done regular patrolling in this area as a result of which the wild animals have got complete protection from Akhand Shikar. Because of his tech-savvy attitude, he has produced many videos on Anukampa App., census App., OFMS App., etc. which have proved highly beneficial to the forest department. Because of his persuasion with the members of Aswakuti VSS, 13 country made guns have been surrendered by the poachers of the area. Sri Sethi has been also responsible for the rescue and release of 1 Sambar deer and 1 Flying Squirrel in Similipal forests. He has also participated in large no of forest raids including 3 nos. of house search.



Sri Prakash Sarkar, Forest Guard of Dabugam Range is a sincere, hard working and disciplined worker. He has achieved high standards in afforestation activities with high survival percentage in the plantations raised by him. Most of the plantations raised by him are having survival percentage 90% or more. He was responsible for the arrest and prosecution of 12 accused persons. He was responsible for the seizure of 1 Bajaj auto rickshaw, 450 cft. of timber and 26.5 q. of firewood. He is a good facilitator so far as Joint Forest Management is concerned. He is responsible for the formation of 15 no. of VSS and conducting 114 no. of VSS meetings. Encroached forest land has been freed from encroachers by Sri Sarkar where afforestation activity has been taken up. Supply of LPG Gas under Ujjwala scheme to VSS members was a great effort by which pressure on natural forest has been minimized.
